



Q1 How long has your child been part of FF?






Q2 How often does your child attend the program?




Q3 Is your child on the D Team?





Q4 I know who my child's coach is?






Q5 I know who to talk to if I have a question about FF?




Q6 I know who the FF Board members are?






Q7 FF board members are welcoming?






Q8 FF board members keep me informed?






Q9 The FF Board acts in a transparent manner?






Q10 I am satisfied with my child's progress?






Q11 FF coaches let me know what my child does well?






Q12 FF coaches let me know what my child is working on?






Q13 I have confidence in FF coaching?


Q14 I am satisfied with the coaching my child gets on technical skiing skills








Q 16 I am satisfied with the coaching my child gets on jumps






Q 17 I am satisfied with the coaching my child gets on moguls




Q 18 I am satisfied with the coaching my child gets on competition preparation




Satisfaction Competition Preparation Coaching




Q19 I believe FF is organized?






Q20 I believe FF keeps me informed about club activities?






Q21 I believe the safety of my child is important to FF?






